INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUESTING OCCUPATIONAL DRIVING
PRIVILEGES ON FRA SUSPENSIONS

If the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles has suspended your driver's license for failing to comply with the Ohio's Financial Responsibility Law, this Court may grant you occupational driving privileges during the period of this suspension.

In order to request the occupational privileges, a petition must be filed with the Erie Count Court, Civil Division, accompanied with a \$85.00 filing fee (NO CHECKS OR CREDIT CARDS! Cash or money orders ONLY).

You must be a resident of Erie County and live in one of the following: Milan Township, Village of Milan, Berlin Township, Village of Berlin Heights, Margaretta Township, Oxford Township, Groton Township or Village of Kelleys Island, EXCEPT within the Villages of Castalia and Bayview. Or in the alternative, received their suspension from a citation filed in Erie County Court.

BEFORE THE COURT WILL CONSIDER GRANTING OCCUPATIONAL PRIVILEGES, THE COURT MUST BE SATISFIED THAT:

- A. Your driver's license has not been suspended due to the Ohio Financial Responsibility Law within the last five (5) years more than once, or is under suspension or license cancellations for any other reason at the current time.
- B. You have paid the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles all reinstatement fees as required for all suspensions.
- C. You have filed current proof of financial responsibility in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 4509.44.
- D. You have paid all outstanding or overdue fines and costs owed to the Erie County Court for all cases.
- E. You completed and returned the occupational driving packet.
